Mareena is a civic association that has been assisting refugees and foreigners in their integration into Slovak society since 2017. It offers the public the opportunity to learn more about the topics of inclusion, migration and diversity.



How do we do it?



We create a friendly environment and organise diverse community events during which local people and people from other countries living in Slovakia can get to know each other. We provide space and support foreigners in creating engaged communities and in making them visible in Slovak society. Schools, businesses and the general public are becoming an integral part of discussions about diversity, identity and equality. To help them navigate through all the available information and look at inclusion from new perspectives, we organise educational workshops on the lives of foreigners in Slovakia. We regularly run information campaigns to bring the topics of hate speech, inclusion, identity and diversity to the public.

We organise language courses, socio-cultural workshops and provide job counselling for people who have found a new home in Slovakia. We help them understand, navigate and be successful in the new job market and society. We provide them with the chance to develop their skills and gain work experience in Slovakia as lecturers in our various educational workshops for the public. In this way, locals can get to know people from other countries and cultures in a natural way and broaden their horizons.

We share expertise

We advise local actors on the inclusion of foreigners at the local level. We participate in research on migration and integration topics, prepare analyses and test innovative approaches in education and research with national and international partners.

- Slovak language courses in Bratislava, Nitra and Košice,

- job counselling,
- mapping of local services for people from Ukraine and coordination with local actors,
- community volunteering and support, in which we engage the potential of people from Ukraine to
 assist their own community by mapping their real needs and providing relevant information,
